Old Testament Reading: Deuteronomy 24:14-22

Deuteronomy 24:14-22 New Living Translation (NLT)

"Never take advantage of poor and destitute laborers, whether they are fellow Israelites or foreigners living in your town. If they cry out to the Lord against you, and it would be counted against you as sin.

"Parents must not be put to death for the sins of their children, nor children for the sins of their parents. Those deserving death must be put to death.

"True justice must be given to foreigners living among you and to orphans, and you must never accept a widow's garment as security.

Always remember that you were slaves in Egypt and that the Lord your God redeemed you from your slavery. That is why I am giving you these commands.

"When you are harvesting your crops and forget to bring in a bundle of grain from your field, don't go back to get it. When you are picking olives from your olive trees, don't go over the boughs twice. Leave the remaining olives for the foreigners, orphans, and widows. Leave the grapes for the foreigners, orphans, and widows.

Remember that you were slaves in the land of Egypt. That is why I am giving you this command.

New Testament Reading: James 5:1-6

James 5:1-6 New Living Translation (NLT)

Look here, you rich people: Weep and groan with anguish because of all the terrible troubles ahead of you. Your wealth is rotting and counting on will eat away your flesh like fire. This corroded treasure you have hoarded will testify against you on the day of judgment. The harvest your fields have reached the ears of the Lord of Heaven's Armies.

You have spent your years on earth in luxury, satisfying your every desire. You have fattened yourselves for the day of judgment.

Gospel Reading: Luke 16:19-31

Luke 16:19-31 New Living Translation (NLT)

Jesus said, "There was a certain rich man who was splendidly clothed in purple and fine linen and who lived each day in luxury. One day a poor man named Lazarus lay at the rich man's door, covered in sores. From the rich man's table, the dogs would come and lick his open sores.

"Finally, the poor man died and was carried by the angels to sit beside Abraham at the heavenly banquet. The rich man, however, was left behind with Lazarus at his side.

"The rich man shouted, 'Father Abraham, have some pity! Send Lazarus over here to dip the tip of his finger in water to cool my tongue, or to dip his foot in water to refresh my feet.'

"But Abraham said to him, 'Son, remember that during your lifetime you had everything you wanted, and Lazarus had nothing. Now he is being comforted here, and you are being tormented. Besides, no one can cross over to you from here, and no one can cross over to us from there.'

"Then the rich man said, 'Please, Father Abraham, at least send him to my father's home. For I have five brothers, and I want them to be warned before it is too late.'

"But Abraham said, 'Moses and the prophets have warned them. Your brothers can read what they wrote.'

"The rich man replied, 'No, Father Abraham! But if someone is sent to them from the dead, then they will repent of their sins.'
